- Is located in the southeast corner of Isanti County and open sunrise to sunset all year for hiking, picnicking, birding, skiing, and canoeing.
- Consists of 173 acres of land, including frontage on two lakes, woods, prairie, and wetlands.
- Long-term plans include over 4 miles of trails, a picnic shelter, canoe access, observation decks, bog walks that will allow access across park wetlands, and prairie and oak savanna restoration.
